



INFORMATION - CONSENT FORM FOR PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

I. INFORMATION

The Hellenic Republic Asset Development Fund ("The Fund"), which is based in Athens, 1 Kolokotroni & Stadiou Str, 105 62, Phone: +30 210 3274400, e-mail: info@hraf.gr, informs every natural person, in its role as controller, that it itself or third parties, as its order and on its own behalf, will process the following data as follows:

A. Type of data

Personal data which will be collected in the context of collecting curriculum vitae shall indicatively include the following: Name, contact information, age, employment history (including job titles and company names), educational information etc.

B. Purpose of Processing

The aim of the processing is to evaluate the curriculum vitae in accordance with the criteria of the Call for Expressions of Interest. The Fund will use identifying and contact data to notify the Candidate with regard to the status of the curriculum vitae submitted.

C. Data Recipients

Recipients of the data listed above (under "A") include: 1. The competent staff of HRADF 2. Advisers to whom the Fund assigns the execution of specific actions on its behalf (processor), provided that confidentiality and the provisions of the GDPR are respected in every case.

II. RETENTION PERIOD

The data under par. A above will be maintained for a period of one year from their date of submission in an electronic and physical file. After the above periods elapses, the personal data shall be destroyed

III. EXERCISE OF RIGHTS

1. The natural person has the right to know what personal data relating to him or her are or have been subject to processing, to request their correction, to raise objections at any time, and to object to the processing of data for purposes other than those described above. In order to exercise their aforementioned rights under the GDPR, the Candidate can contact the Fund in writing (e-mail: dpo@hraf.gr).

2. The Fund has the right to refuse a request to delete the Candidate's data if maintaining such data is necessary to substantiate, exercise, or support its legal rights or the rights of third parties.

IV. FUND OBLIGATIONS

The Fund is required to take every reasonable measure to safeguard confidentiality and security in the processing of data, and to protect the latter from accidental or unlawful destruction, accidental loss, alteration, prohibited transmission or access by anyone, as well as any other form of unlawful processing.
